



Frequently Asked Questions

REGISTRATION:

Q: How do I register for the Virtual Winter Conference?

A: Registration is open for the Conference. [Click here](#) to register.

Q: Do you accept registration via fax or phone?

A: No, registration is online only.

Q: How much is registration?

A: Registration costs are \$100 for members and \$150 for non-members.

Q. When is the registration deadline?

A: January 21, 2026, 12:00pm EDT.

Q. What happens if I need to register after the deadline?

Q: When is the early bird deadline?

A: There is no early bird deadline for the Winter Conference.

Q: What is the Tax Identification Number for NCMS?

Q: What is the cancellation policy?

A: No refunds will be permitted.

GENERAL:

Q: When will I receive the links to login to the Conference?
